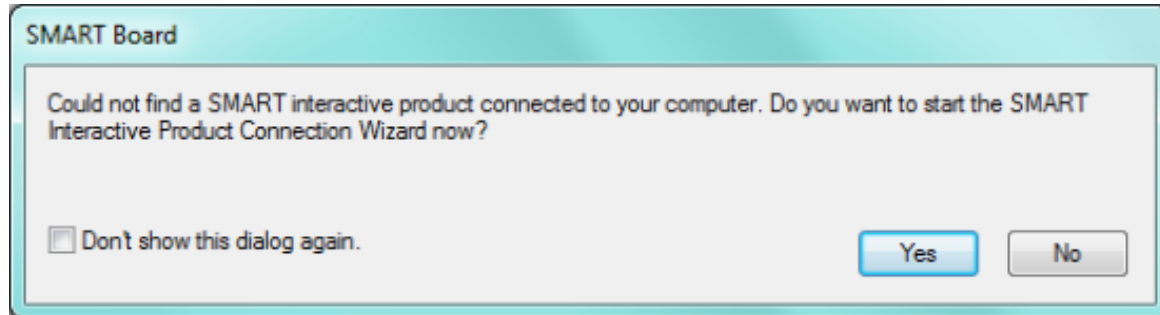




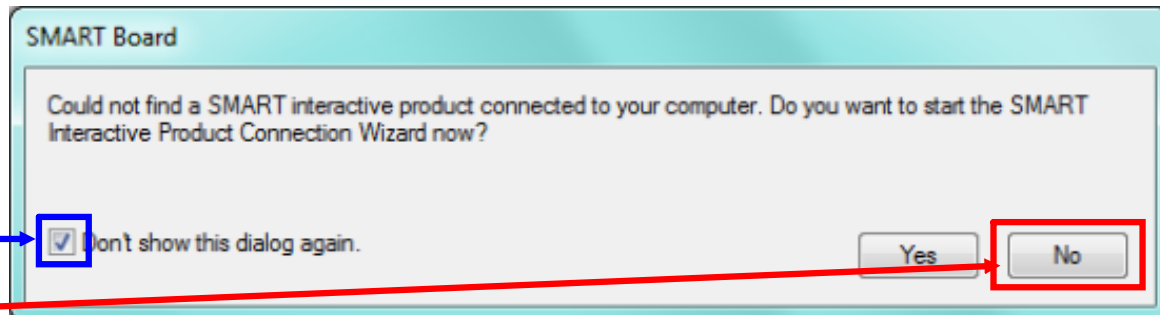
Step 3 - Things To Do First

If the SMART Software is installed on a computer where a SMART interactive product is not connected, the computer will begin to look for a SMART interactive product immediately after the software install.

The Following will appear:



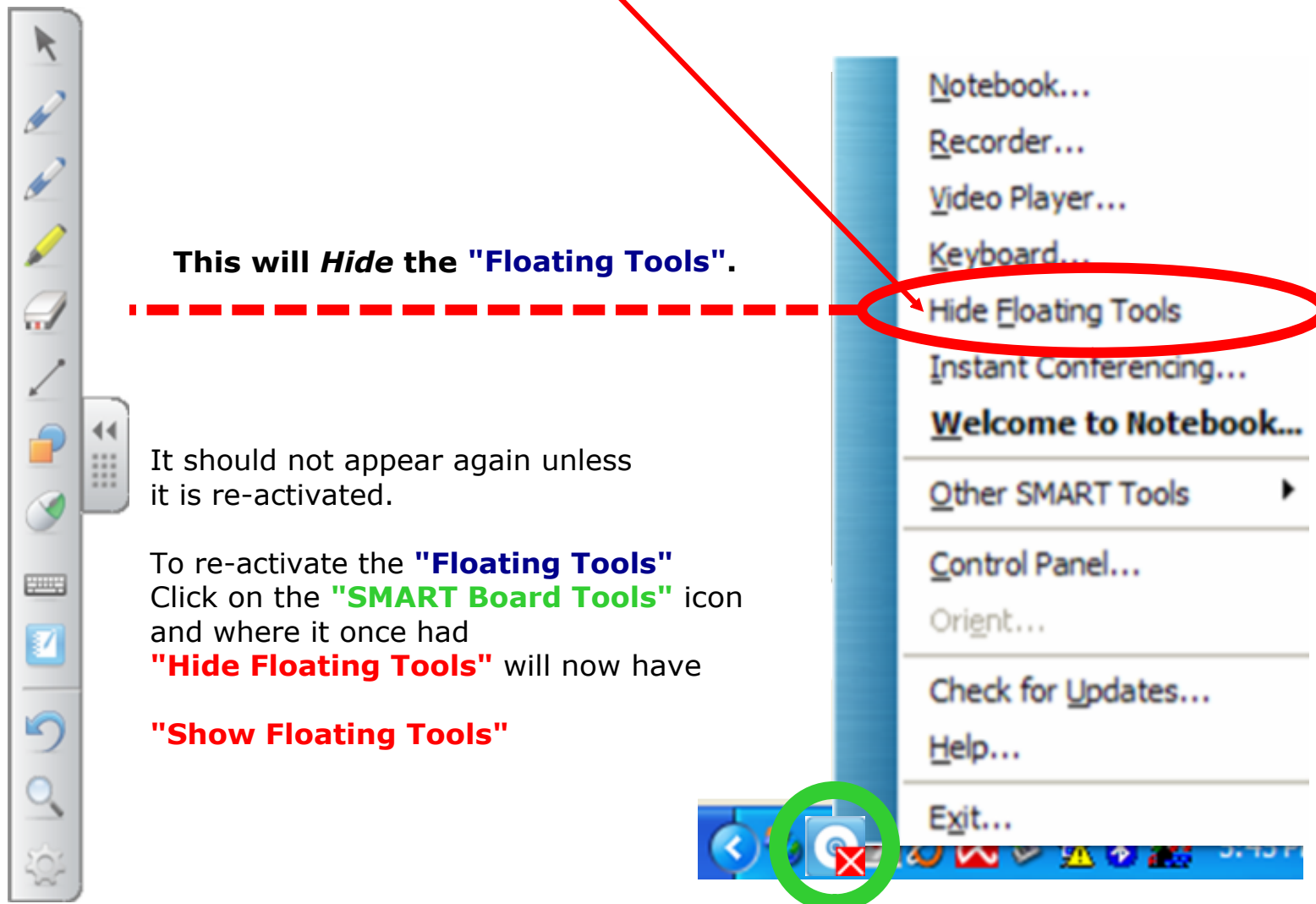
Check the **Box** on,
and the Click **No**.





Step 3 - Things To Do First

Click on the **"SMART Board Tools"** icon {This icon is 'circled' below in Green}.
Click on **"Hide Floating Tools"**



This will *Hide* the "Floating Tools".

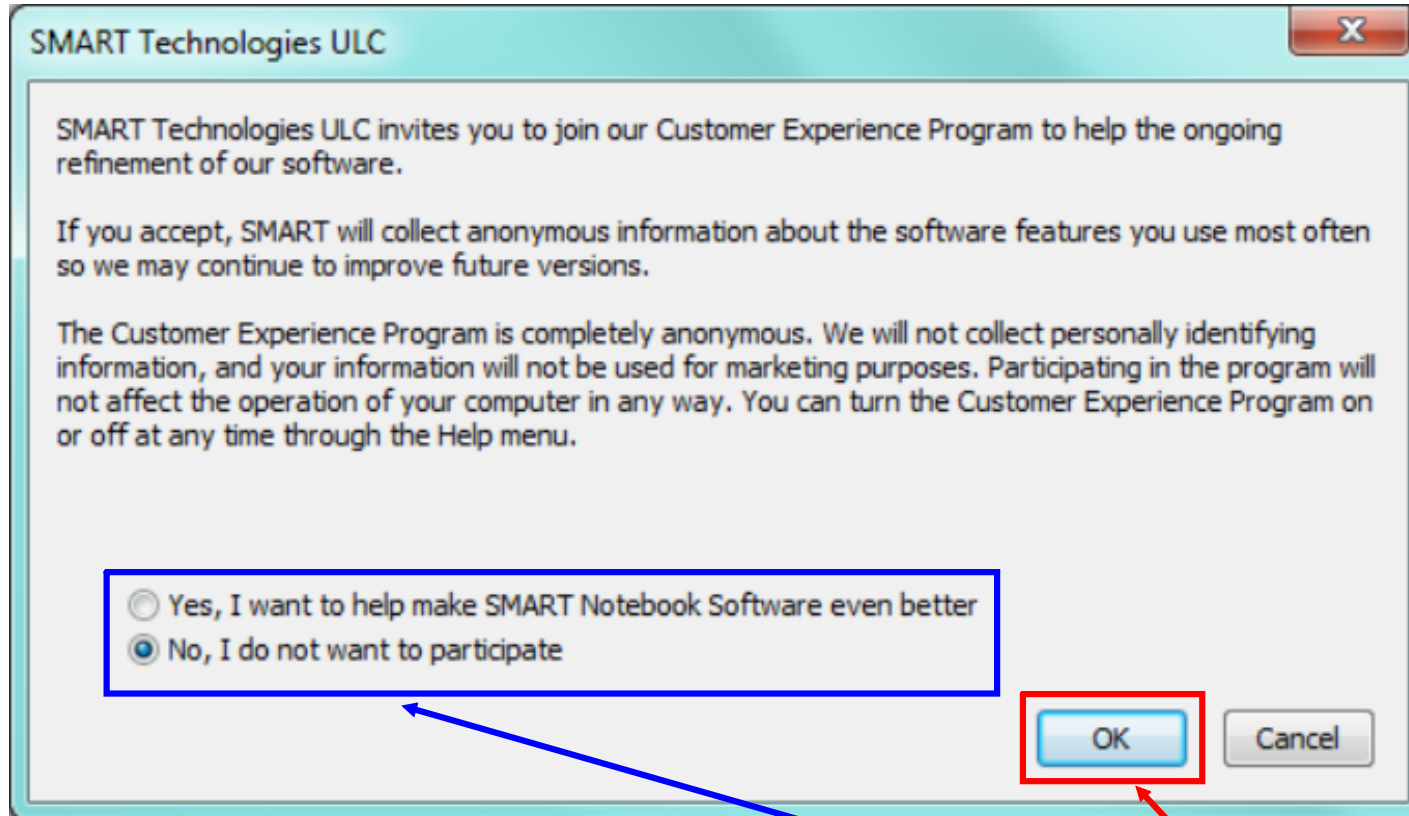
It should not appear again unless it is re-activated.

To re-activate the **"Floating Tools"**
Click on the **"SMART Board Tools"** icon
and where it once had
"Hide Floating Tools" will now have
"Show Floating Tools"

Step 3 - Things To Do First



This "Customer Experience Program" window will appear the very first time SMART Notebook is opened.



The choice to participate is yours. Make a **selection** and click **OK**.

Step 3 - Things To Do First



If you did not enter a **Activation Code (Product Key)** during the installation process, the following window will appear.



This will happen every time SMART Notebook™ is activated until the **Product Key** is entered.

After 30 days, SMART Notebook™ will not function until a **Product Key** is entered.

Please note:

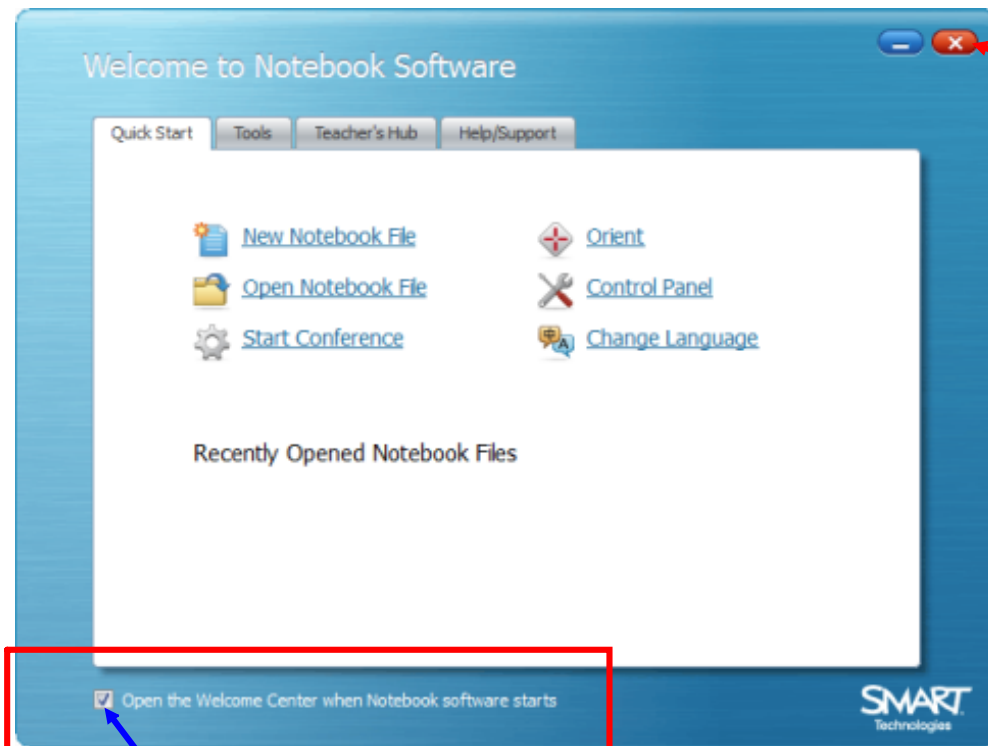
All the current downloads available for SMART Notebook™ Software Version 10 is classified as a 30-Day Trial Version. In order to release the Trial Version Status, the end user must input an Activation Code. This Activation Code will most likely come from your District's Technology Administrator.

This "Welcome to Notebook Software" window will appear every time SMART Notebook is opened.

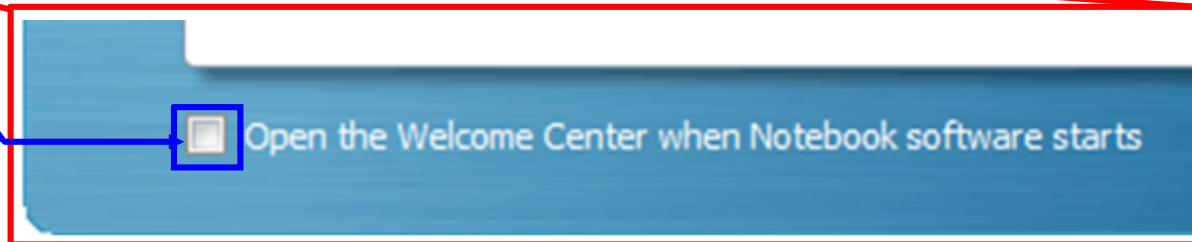


Wait

First Un-Check the **Box** (Look below), and then Click the 'X'.

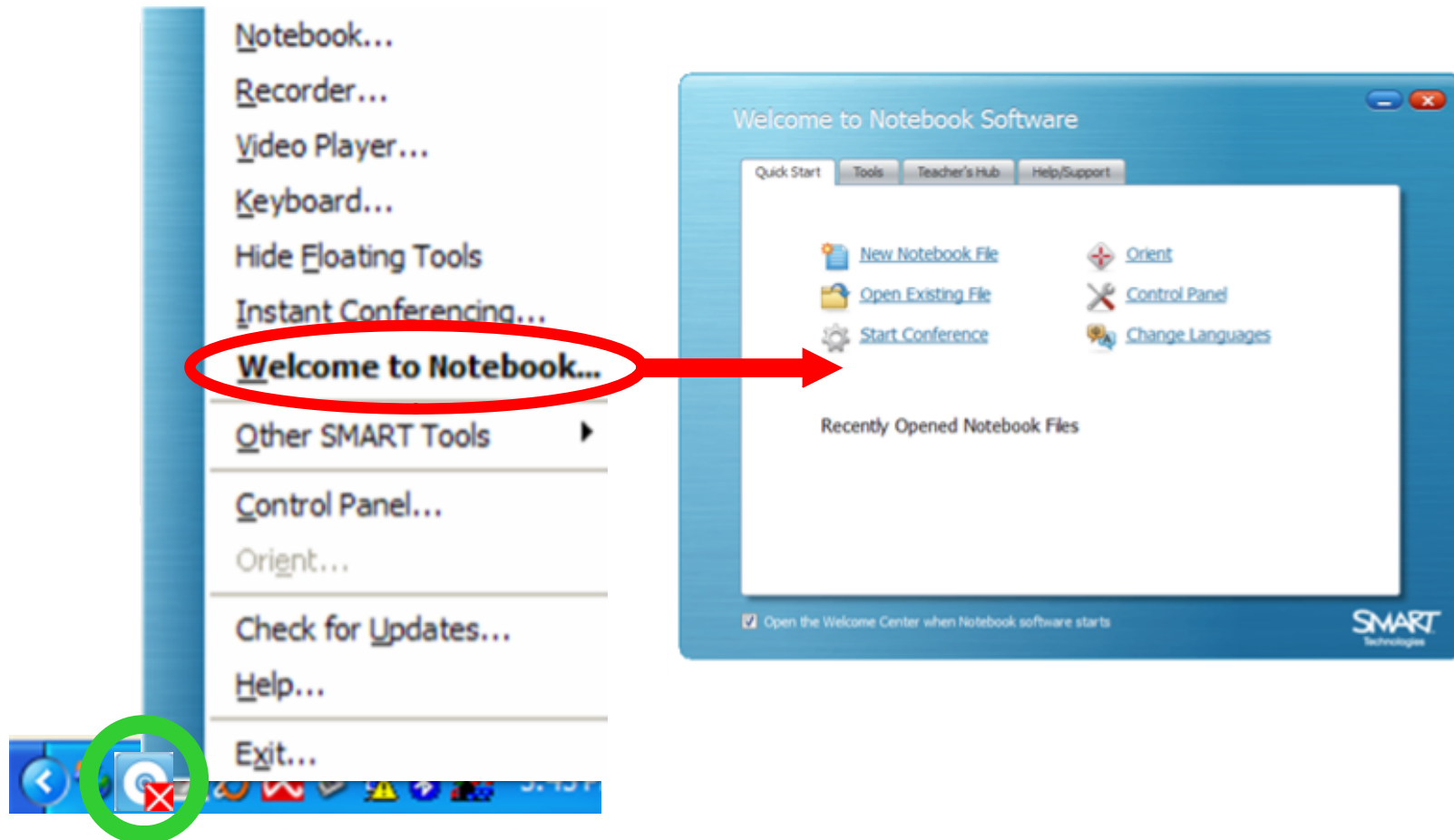
First, Un-Check this **Box**.

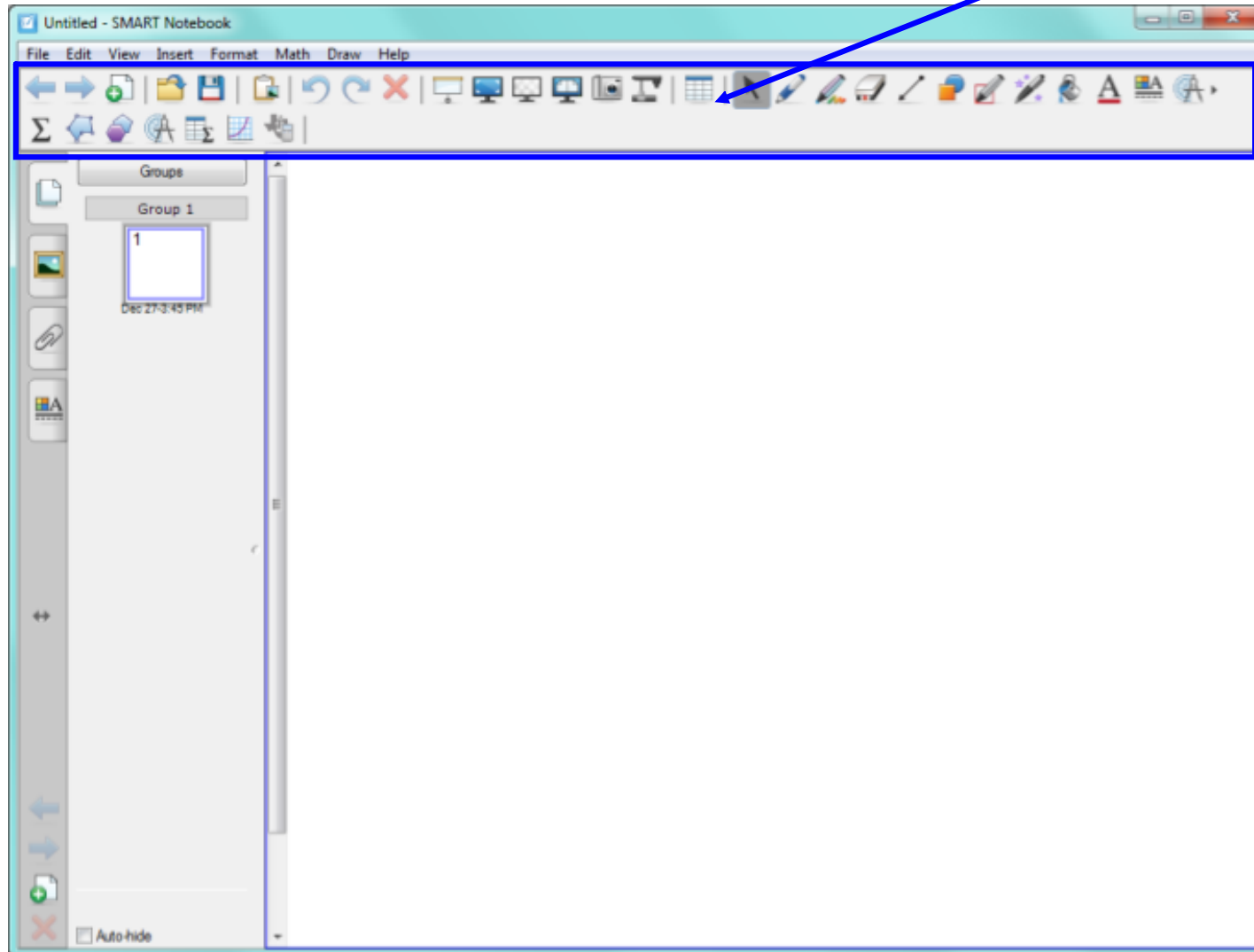


This "Welcome to Notebook Software" window can always be re-accessed by going to the **"SMART Board Tools"** icon and selecting **"Welcome to Notebook..."**

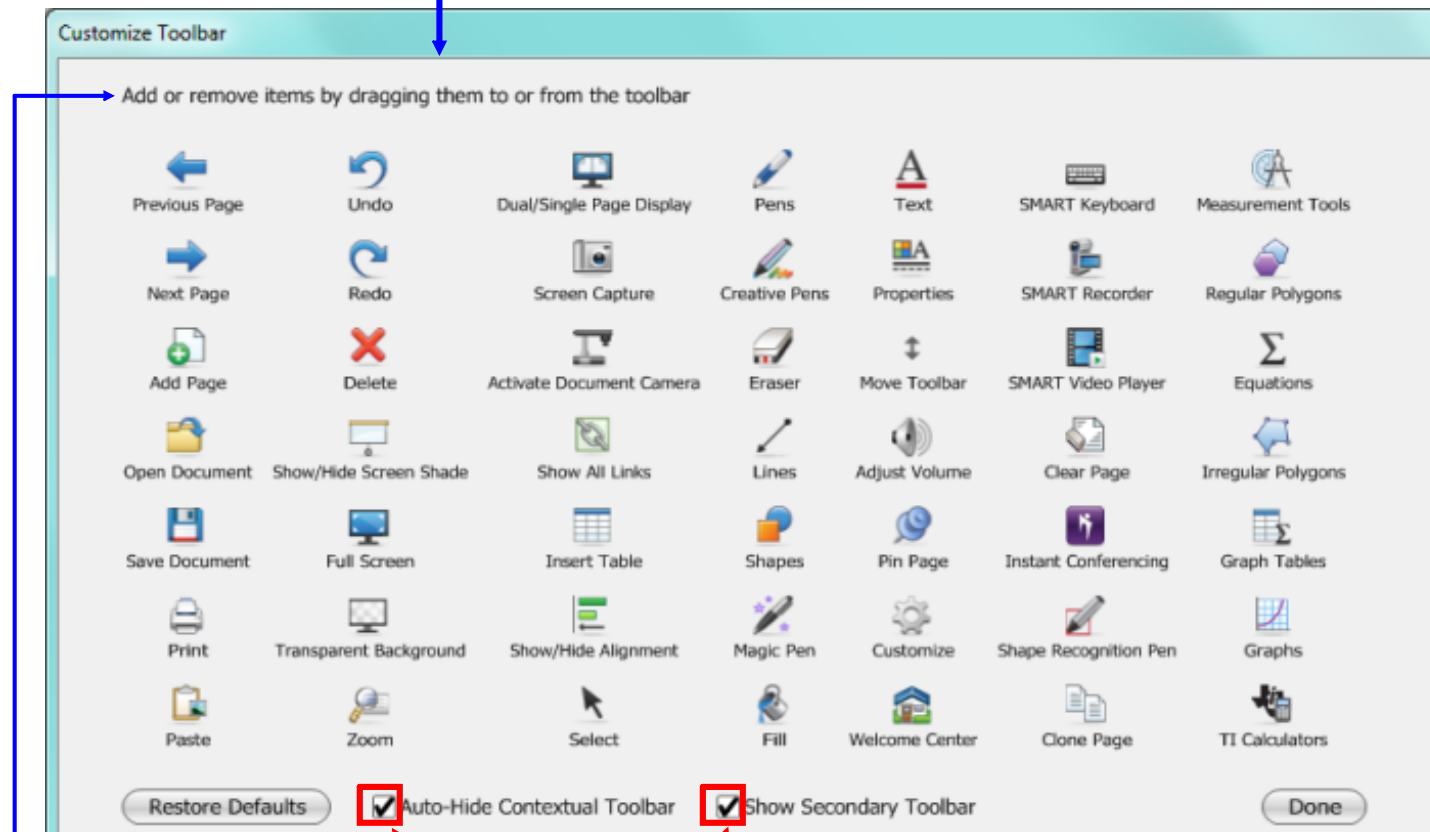
In SMART Notebook, Right Click anywhere on the **"Icon Bar"**

This "Customize Toolbar" window will appear.



Un-Check the **Box** for "Auto-Hide Contextual Tool Bar".

Also, you can Un-Check the **Box** for "Show Secondary Toolbar,
if you do not plan to purchase the SMART Math Tools.

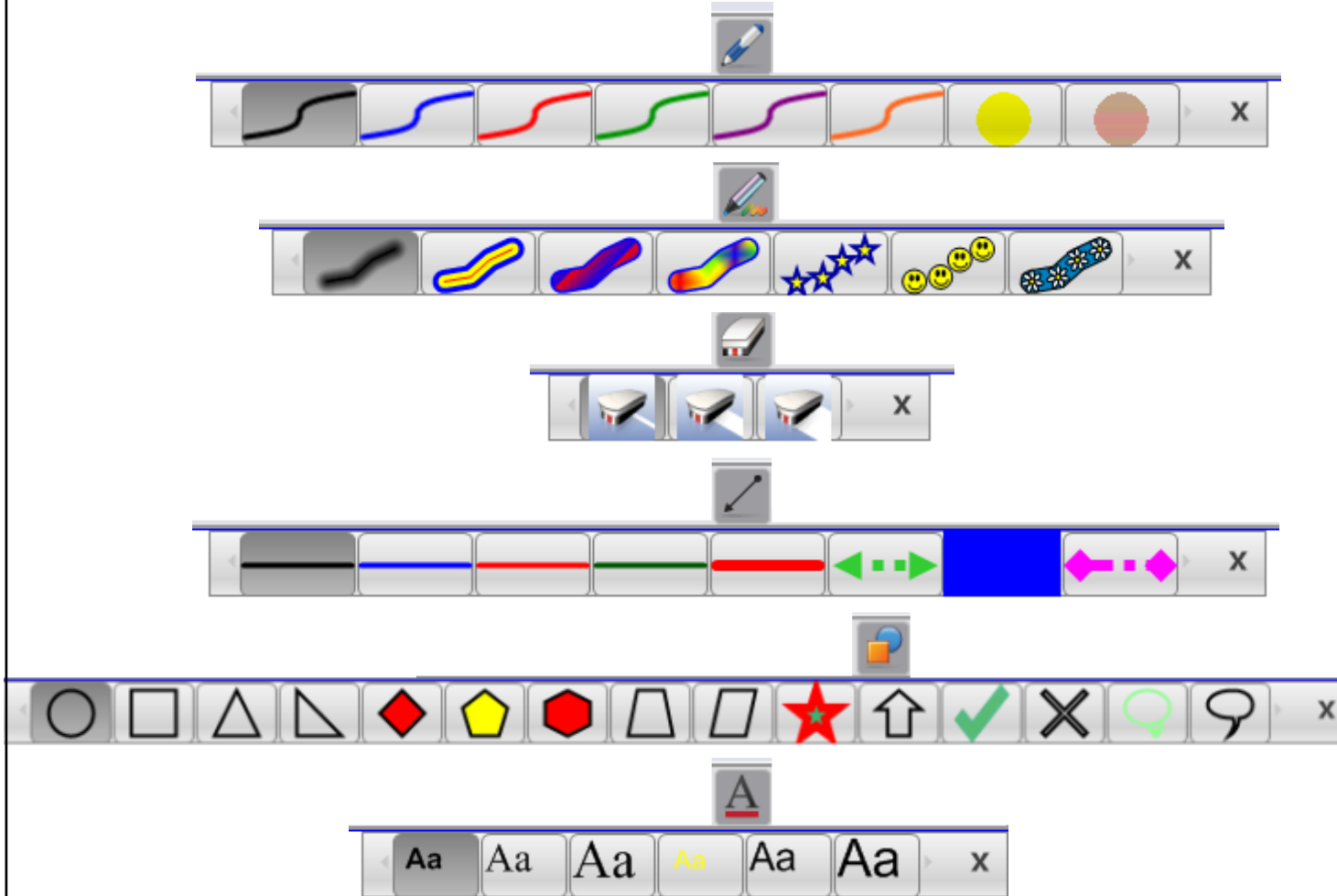
This window will also allow the "Icon Bar" to be changed.

Step 3 - Things To Do First

The Secondary Toolbar is needed only if you purchase the SMART Math Tools.

By Un-Checking the **Box** to turn off the "Auto-Hide Contextual Toolbars" the following tool bars will remain exposed while they are being used.

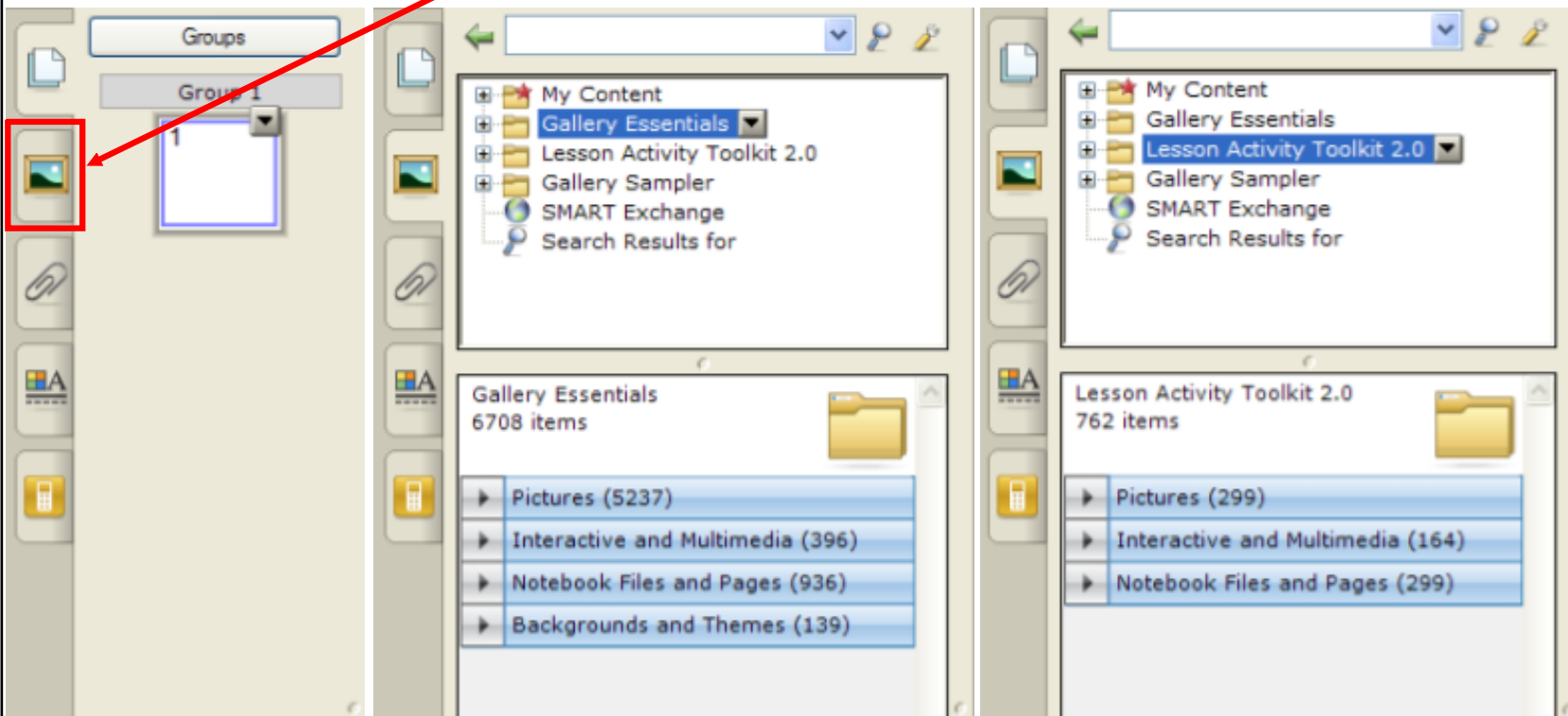
This is very handy to remember what tool is active.





Step 3 - Things To Do First

Check the "Gallery" for the proper amount of content.
Click on the **"Gallery Tab"**.

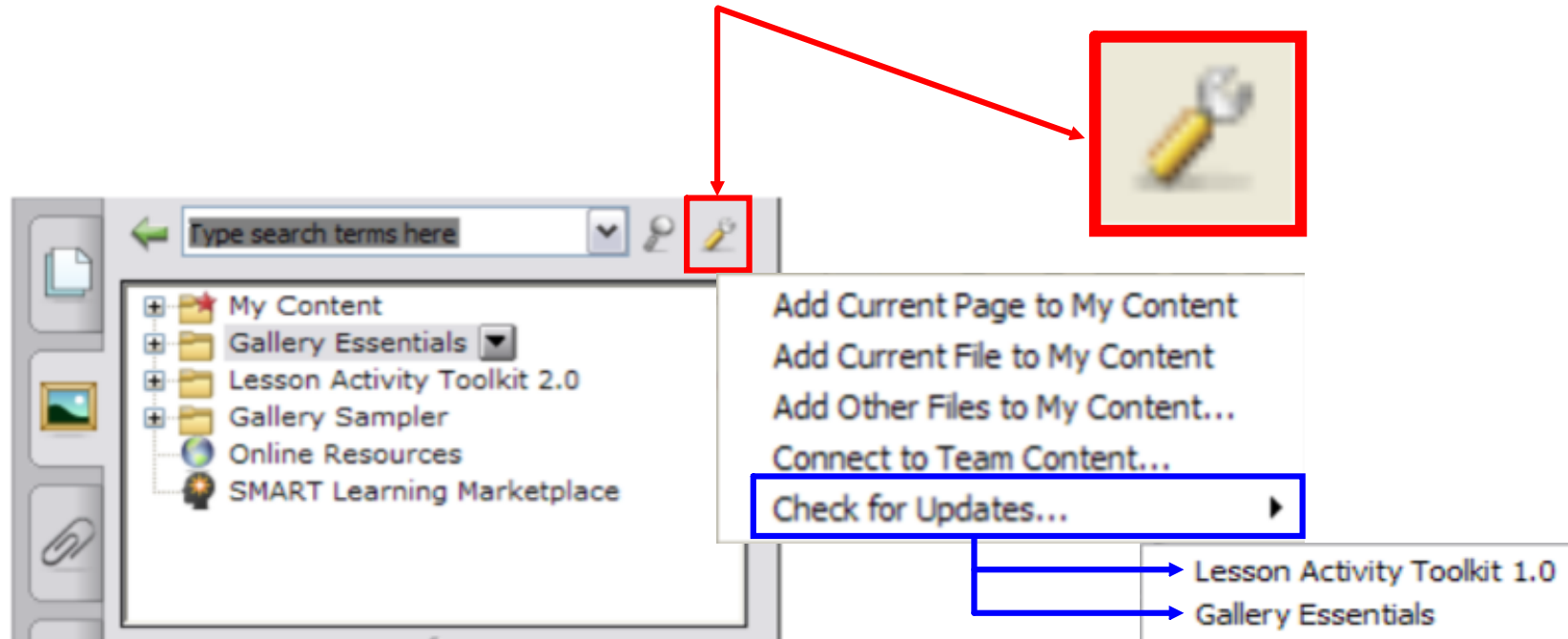


There should be at least 6708 Items

Step 3 - Things To Do First

If the "Gallery" is not up-to-date, it is easily fixed by using the **"Show Additional Gallery Actions"** icon.



Be sure to run both **"Updates..."** if needed.
