Horizontal & Vertical Lines.

Review

$$Ax + By = C$$

(x, y)

If $A=0$: Then $By = C$

If $B=0$: Then $Ax = C$

Still
Graph

Lines

Verbs:

plot: create a point! (must have an ordered pair)

graph: create a line! (will have an equal sign)

If $A=0$: Then $By=C$

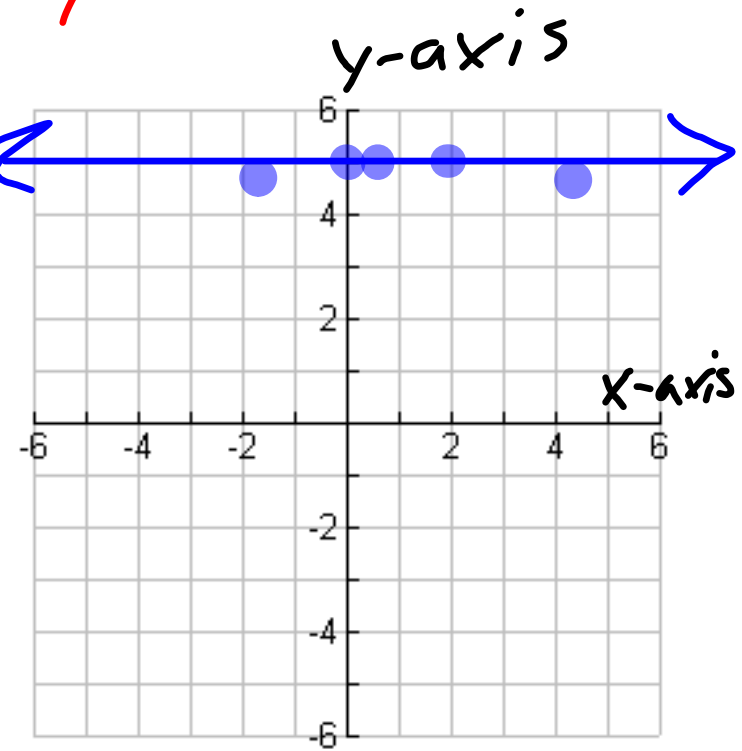
Graph

ex

$$\frac{2y}{2} = \frac{10}{2}$$
$$\underline{\underline{y=5}}$$

If $y=5$, Then it
does not matter
What 'x' is!

This creates a horizontal line



If $B=0$: Then $Ax=C$

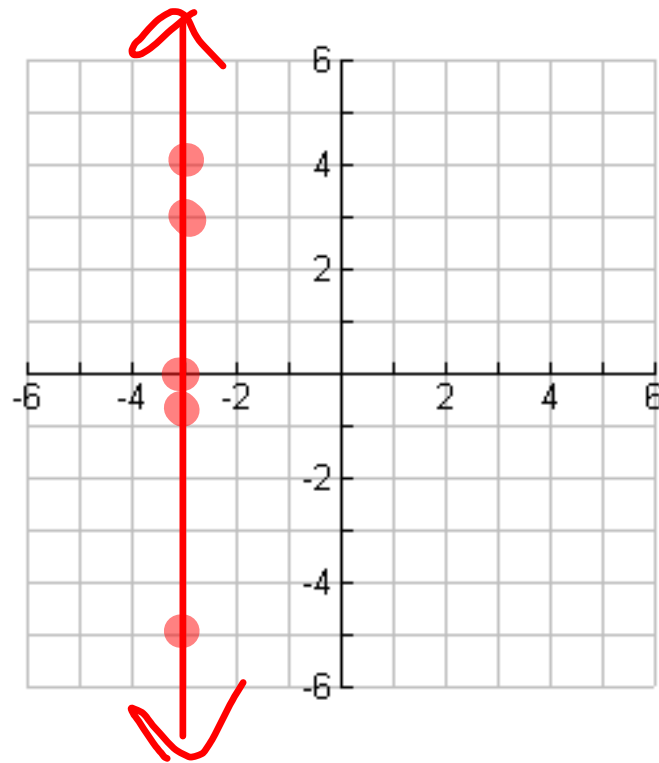
Graph

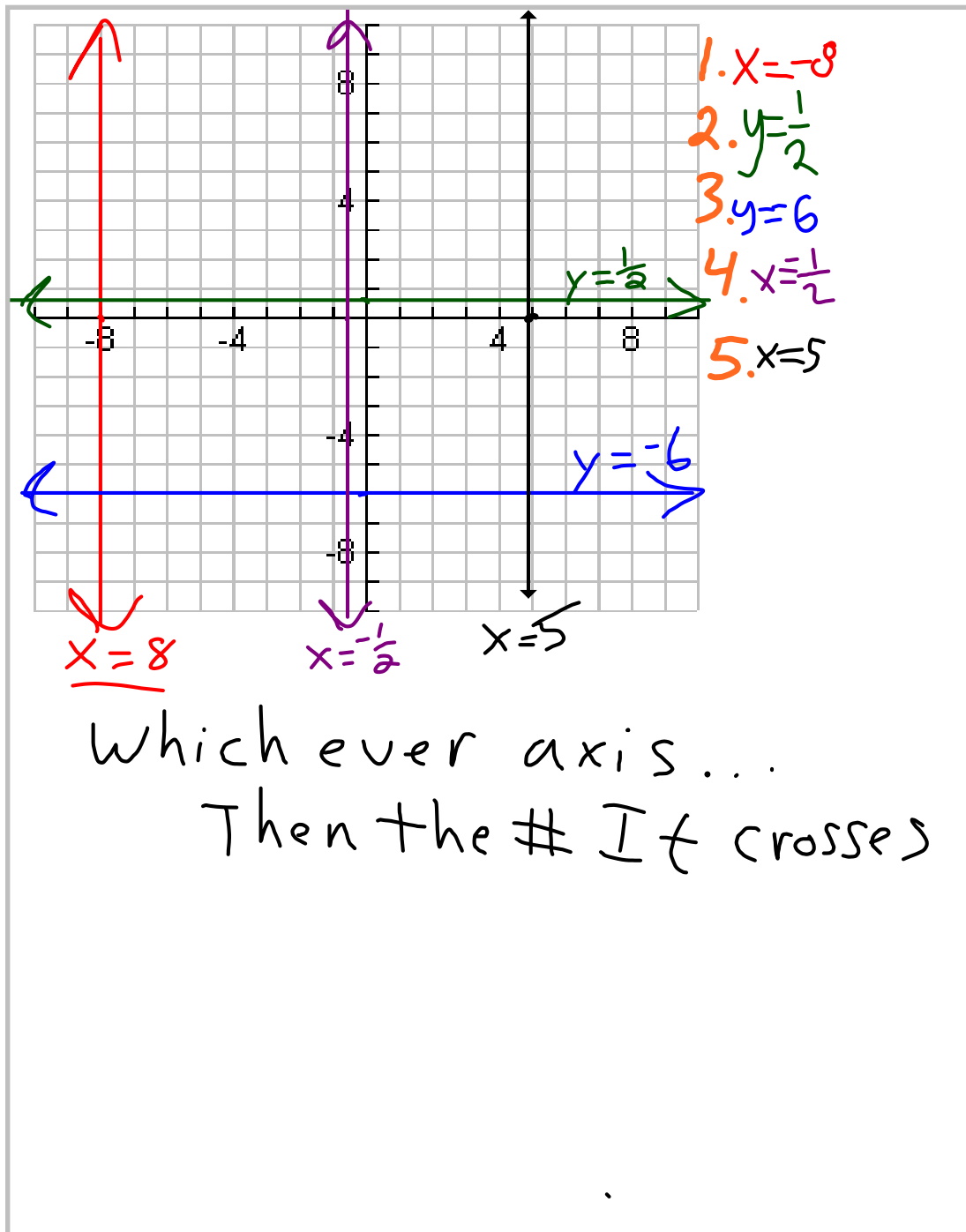
Ex) $\frac{-7x}{-7} = \frac{21}{-7}$

$x = -3$

If $x = -3$, Then it
does Not matter
what y is!

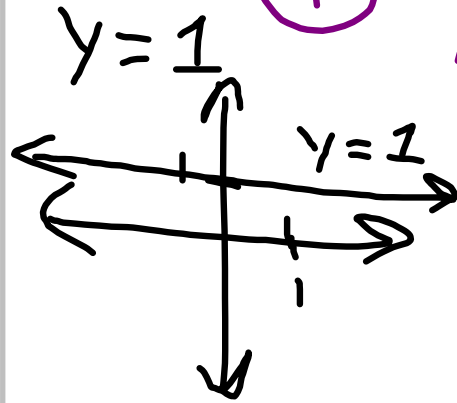
This creates a Vertical line.
