

Here is the information needed to get a TI Emulator for your Computer to use with the SMART Board.

You are going to want to go to

For the calculator emulator.

This is one that TI put out for educators. You will need to set an account with them. Do not worry the calc is free. There you can download the calc. and install it onto the computer. Once it is installed. You are going to need to reboot your machine. Once that is done, an icon called TI 83 Plus Flash debugger will be on your desktop. Open that icon. Then click 'file' 'new' and choose your calculator. This loads the calc. into the program. Then you will need to click 'debug' and 'go'. And the calculator. Will show up on the screen.

This is a little different then the one I showed at the sessions, however, it is better because you can save many different memories for different calculators. And it is 15 times easier to load onto the machine. The one I show at the session takes 35 to 45 mins to load ad this one should take like 10, if that.
